Bob Rose reported new LED streetlights have been installed around the clubhouse and extended a thanks to Katie Gannon and Linda Norris for their help Tom Farkas talked about:

- painting of clubhouse
- power washing of sidewalks around clubhouse
- new pool heater and still using older hot tub heater
- removal of unused power boxes at the pond was completed
- Chuck installing new led bulbs in exterior clubhouse lighting

A motion was made to pay H2O for pressure washing sidewalks on clubhouse common grounds for the amount of \$ 500.00 This motion was seconded and approved.

#### **IX.** New Business:

Voting on making the pool enclosure smoke free was deferred until a later date to access the wishes of all the community and not just those who spoke for and those spoke

against the proposal at the meeting.
