

Board of Directors
Changes to GAVA Rules and Regulations
June 28, 2019

Sheds (new section)

Sheds will be installed in the back and within 1' (one foot) of the house and may not exceed or extend past the rear width of house.

No sheds will be installed on the sides or front of house.

Cannot be more than 100 square feet in size.

Height not more than 10' (ten feet).

Must be anchored to the ground 18" to 24" (inches) deep with at least one anchor in each corner.

All applications for sheds or fences must have a diagram, of size and location, submitted with application. Exceptions will be considered.

Pets

Dogs will be limited in size to 35 pounds at maturity.

Change in "Architectural Change Application" Form

Authorization forms will be changed to require the following:

1. "Action of the Committee" section
 - 2 (two) Board of Directors signatures
 - 3 (three) Architectural Committee members signatures

2. "Final Approval section"
 - 1 (one) Board Director
 - 1 (one) Architectural Committee member

All deviations from original approval must be approved by 2 Board Members in writing.



Fall 2019/Spring 2020 Bocce Sign ups

The 2019-2020 Bocce Season will be starting in just a month. October 14th will be first Bocce day to kick off the season. We need a bunch of fun people to mix and enjoy the company of your friends and neighbors. No experience is necessary, you just have to be able to stand and roll a Bocce Ball down a 60-foot-long court and cheer when your team makes a point. This a great way to meet your neighbors. We start playing at 1PM and play the best out of three games. This usually take about 2 hours.

The teams are selected by a drawing on the day of play, so over the course of the season you will play with or against everyone who signs up.

If you don't want to commit to playing every week, sign up to be a substitute. We always need several substitutes each Bocce Day.

The Bocce signup sheets for Mondays and Thursdays will be posted October 1st in the clubhouse. There has to be a minimum of 8 people (one court) or a Max of 16 people (for two courts). Where we have less than 16 players sign up for a given day, the first 8 people who sign up will be the players.

On Monday's and Thursday's, the teams will be selected by a weekly drawing. If we have enough interest, an optional day (Tuesdays) signup sheet will also be posted.

The Bocce Season will start October 14, 2019 and end May 2, 2020. We will have three (3) Holiday breaks as follows:

Thanksgiving: November 22 – 30

Christmas: December 23 – January 2

Easter: April 6-12

Like all games, Bocce rules vary with who you play with and where you are from. We will be playing by Gull Aire documented rules






