

Times have changed in the Village. In the past residents did not worry much about crime in Gull Aire Village but that all changed in the month of May. We had two of our residents have their golf carts stolen in the middle of the night. We had another resident have items taken from his shed and a key broken off in his front door when someone attempted to enter his home. The board responded to these events by requesting the sheriff have his deputies patrol our community on a regular basis and watch both entrances during the early morning hours. I sent out a list of actions that you can take to protect your personal items and add security to your home on mail chimp. However, we all must continue to ensure we keep our sheds locked and our valuables secured. You might consider contacting your insurance company to see just what coverage they are providing. Is your golf cart covered? What about items you store in your shed? Also, take pictures of all your personal property so you have a record of what you own. If you see something suspicious call either the sheriff's office or 911 and report it.

Recently someone must have thought if a pool chair is broken, or the ribbing is gone we discard the chair. We went through this in the past and found replacing the chairs is much more expensive than repairing them. Please do not throw out worn pool chairs. Instead, please contact Todd Hayward and he will see that they are repaired and placed back in service.

The correct parts finally came in and the pool gate has been repaired and is back in operation. We appreciate your patience. Please never keep a gate open by placing something to restrict it from closing as it is a violation of Florida law. If you find a gate not working properly report it to either Todd, a board member or Alice and we will investigate it.

I know in the last newsletter I wrote about the hurricane season, however, I feel you cannot write enough about it this year. They predict an extremely active season this year. The ocean temperatures heated up earlier than in past years and conditions are ripe for storm and hurricane activity. Be prepared! Visit the Pinellas County Preparedness website or disaster.pinellas.gov for more information. Take the time to take photographs of all your possessions so you have an up-to-date record for insurance purposes. But most importantly stay safe and know your evacuation plan!

# Did you know?

- In it's infancy, GAV allowed children of any age to live here.
- In 1983, GAV became "an 18 and older village".
- Around 1987-1988, GAV became a "55+ community"
- A portion of the "pool rules" in 1984 read as follows:
  - One resident MUST accompany his guests
  - o Guest children under 14 may ONLY use the pool between 10am to noon and 4pm to 6pm
  - o In the early 1980's there WAS a Lifeguard on Duty
- There are 20 missing not assigned address numbers in the convoluted numbering scheme in GAV.
- Sine the 1976 genesis of GAV, our weather extremes have included the "blizzard of 77" when 2/10 inches of snow fell on January 19,1977. The lowest temperature of 19 degrees was recorded on January 13, 1981, and the highest temperature of 102 took place on July 10, 1997.
- Oldsmar's population was estimated at just over 2,000 in 1976 when GAV was conceived and the 2015 estimate puts the City's resident count at just under 14,000.
