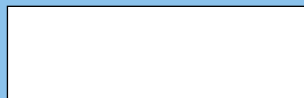
One of our most popular weekly traditions remains our Bingo gatherings, where residents come together for laughter, friendly competition, and great prizes.

Architectural Guidelines


I have reflected on this matter for quite some time, and it is important to clarify the scope of the committee's responsibilities. While we review and approve applications in accordance with the established guidelines governing Gull Aire Village, there appears to be a growing tendency among residents to inquire excessively into the details of what others are doing on their private property without first inquiring to see if they are really ok.

The committee consistently strives to provide sound guidance and to uphold the rules and regulations. If a homeowner chooses to exceed or disregard those rules, that decision ultimately rests with them. Such situations should not become a source of neighborhood speculation or gossip. If a resident believes a violation has occurred and wishes to address it appropriately, the proper course of action is to contact the City of Oldsmar Code Enforcement. You do have to give your name and address and what the violation is and this can be done online thru the city website. Sometimes these violations that you think are wrong are indeed ok but wanted you to know what your course of action was rather than talking without finding out the facts first. You may also contact a committee member about it. Those members are Jill Kauss, Ralph Richardson, Carl Foley, Randy Collinsworth and Peggy Allison.

Gull Aire Village is responsible for addressing only certain internal matters, such as unmaintained yards, disruptive behavior, underage occupancy, neglected vehicles or other similar issues. However, issues involving deteriorating structures, improperly installed pavers, or other property conditions that fall outside our jurisdiction should be handled by the city. The Architectural Committee makes every effort to thoroughly review all applicable rules and guidelines. It is important to note that just because something may have been permitted or not permitted in the past does not mean it is acceptable or not acceptable under current standards. Both Gull Aire Village regulations and the City of Oldsmar's requirements have evolved over the years, and all decisions must reflect the rules as they exist today. We just want to clear up a lot of confusion. In the last four months we probably have only had 4 applications and two did not need approvals at all.

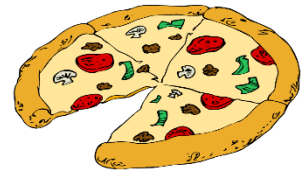
